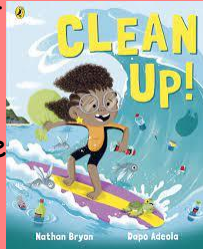




Year 1
Summer 2 2022 - The Seaside
(Second half term)

English

In English, we will listen to the story *The Pirates Next Door*; we will explore and apply our knowledge of descriptive language to write character descriptions. Using the story *Clean Up!* as a stimulus, we will produce information booklets to explain how and why it is important to keep our beaches and oceans litter free. We will use our senses to write poems about the seaside.



History /Geography

In history, we will use sources of evidence to learn about the seaside in the past, and compare this to seaside holidays today. The children will learn about Horatio Nelson and his links to Norfolk.



Art & Design / Design Technology

Our DT unit is 'structures'. We will plan, make and evaluate a windmill using a range of materials and techniques.



Maths

In maths, children will be learning the following:

- * Number: place value (within 100)
- * Geometry: position and direction
- * Measurement: money
- * Measurement: time
- * Daily arithmetic practice



Computing

In computing, the children will be introduced to spreadsheets. The second unit will be centred around technology outside school.



PE & Music

PE for this half term will be athletics and invasion. In music, the unit will be 'Musical Devices'.



Science

In science, we will be learning about seasonal changes. The children will name and describe types of weather and explain the changes that happen across the seasons. They will explore how plants and animals adapt to different seasonal conditions.



RE & RSHE

We follow the current Norfolk syllabus for RE. Our key enquiry question is: How did the universe come to be? (Hindu and Christian perspective). In RSHE, our focus will be 'Our Body' including first aid.
