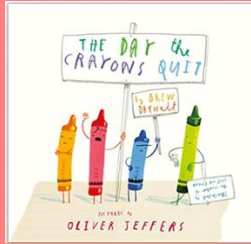




Year 1

### English

In English, we be looking at the book 'The Day the Crayons Quit'; we will write persuasive letters and letters of complaint. After our trip to the Time and Tide Museum, we will be writing a recount. In poetry, we will be learning a poem to perform called 'Billy McCool' by Aoife Mannix. We will continue to practise our handwriting and spellings as well.



### Maths

In maths, children will be learning the following, some of which we will be revisiting:

- \* Daily arithmetic practice
- \* Geometry: position and direction
- \* Measurement: money, mass, capacity & temperature
- \* Measurement: time



### Science

In science, we will continue to look at plants and how they grow. We will look at different plants around the world and how they adapt to survive. We will also look at plants closely and identify different species.



### History /Geography

In history, we will use sources of evidence to learn about the seaside in the past, and compare this to seaside holidays today. The children will learn about Horatio Nelson and his links to Norfolk.



### Art & Design / Design Technology

Our DT unit is structures. We will plan, make and evaluate a windmill using a range of materials and techniques.



### Computing

In computing, the children will be 'Making Music'. The second unit will be "Presenting ideas".



### PE & Music

PE for this half term will be athletics and invasion. In music, the unit will be recorders.



### RE & RSHE

We follow the current Norfolk syllabus for RE. Our key enquiry question is: What do religious people say God is like? In RSHE, our focus will be 'Our Body' including first aid.
