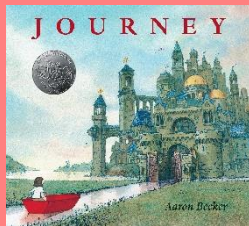




Year 3

English

In English, we will write persuasive texts. We will also write a journey tale, diamante and calligram poem. We will use Journey by Aaron Becker and other texts to support our reading and writing.



Maths

In maths children will be learning, through fluency, reasoning and problem-solving activities:

- * Number: fractions
- * Number: addition, subtraction, division, multiplication methods
- * Geometry, measures and statistics
- * Daily arithmetic practice



Science

Our focus for this half term is animals including humans. In this unit we will look at the digestive system in humans and different types of teeth and their functions.



Computing

Using Purple Mash, we will focus on simulations and graphing.



MFL

For our French work we will focus on colours, size and shape.



Geography

In geography we will continue to look at rivers, focusing on some different rivers and their uses. We will also look at some UK geography, identifying geographical regions and major cities. In our local area, we will also look at the River Waveney.
