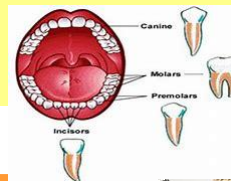
Maths In maths children will be learning through fluency, reasoning and problem-solving activities:

- Daily arithmetic practice
- Daily times table fluency
- Statistics
- Geometry
- Position and direction



Science

In science we are learning about the digestive system in humans and animals, covering basic human digestion, teeth, food chains and animal diet groups.



RSHE Our learning this term is around *My Body* and we will also learn about tobacco, alcohol and drugs.
