Ancient Greece

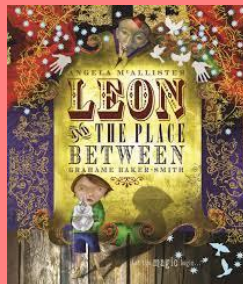
History & Geography

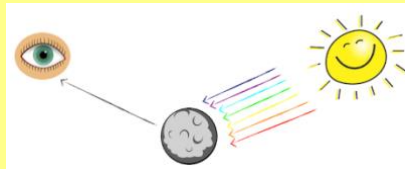
Music
