We will focus our learning on developing our knowledge of the physical and human characteristics of Greece.

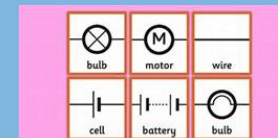


History

We will develop our understanding of electrical systems.



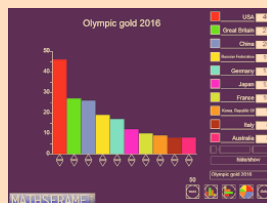
Maths
