




Reception Autumn 2 2022 - Reach for the Stars

Communication and Language

Children will practise concentrating, listening and following instructions. They will respond to stories, develop their vocabulary and use language to imagine and pretend. They will be encouraged to ask and answer questions and to express themselves clearly, sequencing and connecting ideas using longer sentences.



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be helping the children to build confidence and relationships with others. They will be encouraged to initiate conversations, listen to and begin to negotiate with their friends as well as talk about their learning. The children will continue to learn about our Acorns Agreements and learn how to be respectful citizens of our school community.



Physical Development

The children will continue to develop their fine motor control through daily dough disco and funky fingers activities. Within PE children will practise stopping safely and using and sharing equipment. They will develop fundamental movement skills such as running, jumping and skipping.



Literacy

Children will be inspired by stories and books. We will continue to teach the children new sounds and tricky words in our daily phonics lessons. We will support the children in reading and writing to use sounds and words that they have learnt.



Maths

Children will be learning to subitise within 5 and will be able to count, compare and compose numbers. We will introduce positional language and deepen our understanding of basic shapes.



Understanding the World

We will talk about festivals and celebrations from different cultures and around the world. We will continue to observe how the environment changes through autumn into winter during Wild Wednesday sessions.



Expressive Arts and Design

We will explore instruments, a variety of materials and colour mixing. Children will be encouraged to use imaginative storylines in their play and will be learning a dance for our school nativity.



RE

We follow the current Norfolk syllabus for RE. This will include learning about the Christmas story.

RHSE

Children will continue to identify and describe their feelings. We will learn the importance of basic hygiene and keeping ourselves and others safe.
