PE

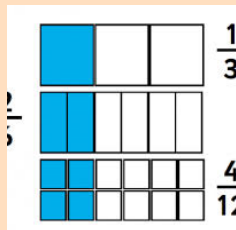

Maths

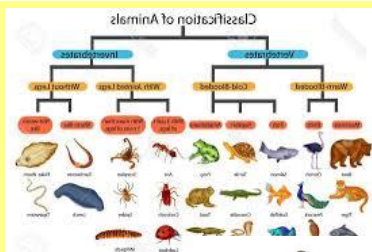
In maths children will be learning, through Fluency, Reasoning and Problem Solving:

- Daily arithmetic practice and times tables fluency
- Fractions
- Shape
- Mass and capacity



Science

Our focus in science is 'Animals including Humans.' We will compare and classify different animal groups and discuss the food chain and their differing nutrition and life-cycles.



RSHE & Computing

In RSHE we will discuss our beliefs and learn about water safety. In computing we will learn about email safety and continue our touch-typing skills.



Music

In music, we will be developing our melodies and composition skills, focussing on a song inspired by Chinese New Year.

In RE, we will respond to the philosophy question: What is the Bible and how is it interpreted?
