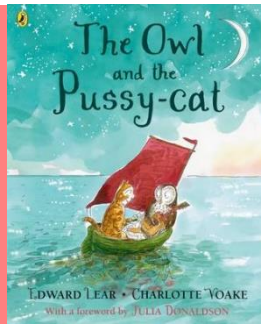




Year 1

Art & Design / Design Technology

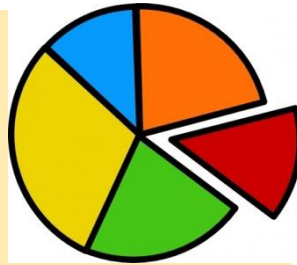
In a combined art and DT project we will be exploring materials and creating a pirate flag using a range of techniques including sewing, cutting and weaving.
