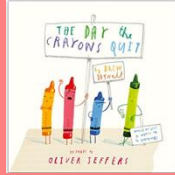




Year 2 Summer 1 2023 - Pirates Ahoy!

English

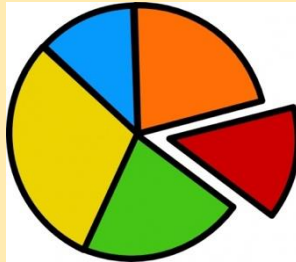
In English, our poetry unit focuses on performance poetry and we will learn and perform the poem Billy McCool, about a sea monster. We will be writing a non-chronological report on different habitats. We will begin to read and respond to the text, The Day the Crayons Quit. Spellings will be tested on a Friday.



Maths

In maths children will be learning the following:

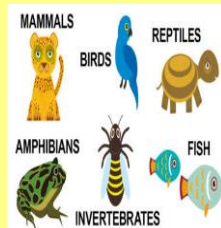
- *Number: fractions
- *Measurement: time
- *Geometry: position and direction
- *Statistics



Pupils will also complete daily arithmetic practice and will have a weekly times table test every Friday.

Science

In science, we will begin to learn about plants, and will look at the difference between a bulb and a seed and the stages of growth. We will also be looking at some different habitats including habitats around the world.



History / Geography

In geography, we will explore mapping, and use and follow compass directions. We will be studying the local area and do some field work.



Art & Design / Design Technology

In a combined art and DT project we will be exploring materials and creating a pirate flag using a range of techniques including sewing, cutting and weaving.



Physical Education

This term our focus is striking and fielding and team building.



Music & Computing

In music, we will be exploring myths and legends. In computing we are learning about 'creating pictures', looking at different styles of painting and recreating them digitally.



RE & RSHE

We follow the current Norfolk syllabus for RE. Our key enquiry question is: Why do people have different views about the idea of God? In RSHE we will focus on rights and responsibilities.
