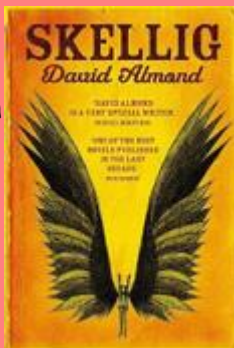




**Year 5**

## English

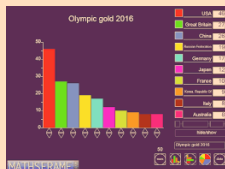
We will start the term by reading Shakespearean sonnets and discussing poetic language. We will also read a version of *Romeo and Juliet* and use this to inspire our own writing. We will also be reading *Skellig* by David Almond and using this to inspire a creative narrative, using our toolkit to support with independent writing (alongside grammar and punctuation activities). Spellings, using the rules, will be set and tested weekly every Friday.



## Maths

In maths children will be learning, through fluency, reasoning and problem-solving activities

- \* Number: addition, subtraction, division, multiplication methods, and ratio and proportion in Year 5
- \* Geometry, measures and statistics
- \* Daily arithmetic practice and gap questions



## Science

In Science we will be developing our understanding of living things and their habitats; learning more about reproduction and life cycles.



## Computing

We will completing the unit: *Game Creator* and 3D Modelling.



## Geography

We will focus our learning on developing our knowledge of where we live: looking specifically at the similarities and differences between Norwich city and Bressingham village, and making comparisons with the wider world, using prior learning.



## Art

In art, we will find out about William Morris and print-making.



## PE

We will be keeping active in different ways and building fitness and resilience through: the daily run, cricket and golf.



## Music

Our learning will be exploring composition to represent the *Festival of Colour* using the Holi Festival as our theme.



## RE

In RE, we will be exploring the question: What difference does the resurrection make to Christians? Is resurrection reasonable?

We will be discussing rights and responsibilities and how to ask for help.

We will be learning about French verbs and their construction.
