English

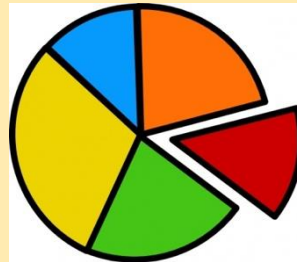
In English, our poetry unit focuses on Pirates - we will be learning and writing some pirate poems. We will be learning and innovating the story 'Little Charlie', making sure we add in great vocabulary and more complex sentences. The children will write a recount about an event in school. Spellings will be tested on a Friday.



Maths

In maths children will be learning the following:

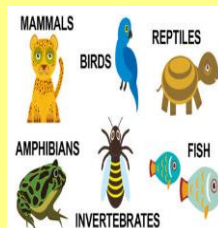
- *Geometry: position and direction
- *Statistics
- *Measurements
- *Money



Pupils will also complete daily arithmetic practice and will have a weekly times table test every Friday.

Science

In science, we will continue to learn about plants, and will look at the stages of growth and what plants need to survive. We will also continue looking at some different habitats including habitats around the world.



History / Geography

In geography, we will be looking at Jamaica and comparing this to our local area.



Art & Design / Design Technology

In a combined art and DT project we will be exploring materials and creating a pirate flag using a range of techniques including sewing, cutting and weaving.



Physical Education

This term our focus is invasion games and athletics.



Music & Computing

In music, we will be learning how to play the recorder.

In computing we are learning about 'Making Music' and 'Presenting ideas'.



RE & RSHE

We follow the current Norfolk syllabus for RE. Our key enquiry question is: Why do people have different views about the idea of God? In RSHE we will look at the topic 'My Body' and first aid.
