English

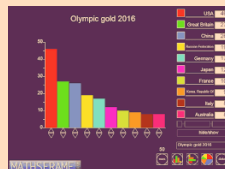

Maths

In maths children will be learning, through fluency, reasoning and problem-solving activities

- * Number: addition, subtraction, division, multiplication methods, and ratio and proportion in Year 5
- * Geometry, measures and statistics
- * Daily arithmetic practice and gap questions



Science

In Science we will be developing our understanding of animals and humans. This will also include investigating the human life cycle.



Computing

We will be completing the unit: 3D Modelling and Concepts Maps.



Geography

We will continue our learning on developing our knowledge of where we live: looking specifically at the similarities and differences between Norwich city and Bressingham village, and making comparisons with the wider world, using prior learning.
