Design Technology/Art and Design

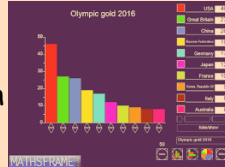
We will start by completing a holiday bag, which we have spent time designing. Next, in art and design, we will complete some printing work based on the artist and designer, William Morris.
