In whole class reading lessons, we will read and discuss *Kensuke's Kingdom*, *Counting on Katherine* and *The Tyger*.



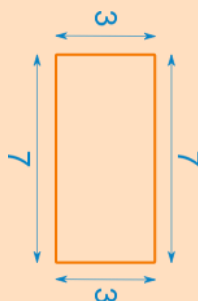
Maths

Our focus question is:

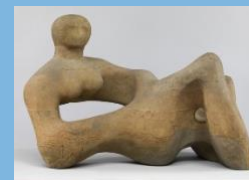
Who lives in Antarctica?
