### English

This term in English we will be writing a journey tale using an extract from Clockwork to support our learning. We will also be writing formal and informal letters and will be using the book Friend or Foe by Michael Morpurgo in our learning.

Spellings will be tested weekly on a Friday.



### History

Our key question this half term will be 'What was the impact of WW2 on the people of Britain'? For this we will be looking at how the war started, how the Battle of Britain was won, the Blitz, evacuation, and migration.



### Art and design

This half term we will be completing a unit based on sculpture and interactive installations.



### Maths

In maths children will be learning, through fluency, reasoning and problem-solving activities

- \* Position and direction

Pupils will also complete daily arithmetic practice and gap questions and will have a weekly times table test and arithmetic test every Friday.



### PE

This half term we will be focusing on golf and cricket.



### Music

We will be completing a unit about composition to represent the festival of colour.



### Science

In Science we will be completing a unit on the life cycles of different types of animals. We will then move on to look at reproduction in mammals, and plants including asexual reproduction.
