
Reading

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| <p>Topic</p> | <p>Watch the clip: Only One You!</p> <p>We would love you to design your own stone. The design and media that you use to design your stone is completely up to you. We would like them to be personal to you, just like in the story. At a later date, we would like to collect the stones and use these to form a trail similar to the picture.</p>  |
