Wrap around care to support busy parents

Before School Club runs from 7.45am to 8.40am for £6 per session; After School Club runs from 3.20pm to 4.20pm for £6 per session, and from 3.20pm to 5.00pm or 5.30pm for £10 or £12, depending on pick-up time.

Many after School Clubs (netball, art, gardening, choir, etc.) usually run (subject to demand and volunteers) for different age groups and are mostly free of charge.

Children remember when they learn through memorable moments. We have an engaging and purposeful curriculum, together with our memorable moments, to challenge children, but also bring the curriculum alive in a creative and exciting way.

Excellence in sports and Forest Schools

At Bressingham we love sports. We have used our Sports Premium Funding wisely to build a sports legacy for the school.



- Usually we have after-school sports activities available.
- We take part in interschool sporting events, when possible.
- We have had our playgrounds resurfaced.

We have a **Forest Schools** group on a Friday afternoon, and **Wild Wednesday** for our reception children on a Wednesday, when they are outside almost all day. We love being outside!

Small classes in Early Years and Key Stage 1

We are a small village school and invest in giving the children the best start possible in small teaching groups with a high teacher to pupil ratio. Our children benefit from small teaching groups in EYFS, Year 1 and Year 2. Currently these range from 20 to 25 pupils. Currently, we also have individual year group classes in Key Stage 2, but we may not always do this. We want to nurture our children towards the highest possible standards, whilst also supporting them to be confident, rounded individuals.
